BOARD ORDER 2017-08 – ERRATA

WHEREAS:

- A. The Yukon Utilities Board (Board) issued Board Order 2017-08 on October 18, 2017 pertaining to Yukon Energy Corporation’s (YEC) application for approval of revenue requirements for 2016 and 2017 and direction regarding the Yukon Court of Appeal judgement, *Yukon Energy Corporation v Yukon Utilities Board, 2017 YKCA 15*.
- B. Board Order 2017-08 ordered YEC to file a separate two-part application to comply with the direction from the Yukon Court of Appeal and further directions from the Board within 30 days of the issuance of the order from the Yukon Court of Appeal. However, Appendix A to Board Order 2017-08 – Reasons for Decision stated on page 6 that YEC is directed to provide correspondence to the Board within 30 days of issuance of the Yukon Court of Appeal order, as to when it expects to file a revised application to address the ERA issue.
- C. Board Order 2017-08 incorrectly stated that YEC is to file the separate two-part application to comply with the direction from the Yukon Court of Appeal and further directions from the Board within 30 days of issuance of the order from the Yukon Court of Appeal.

NOW THEREFORE, the Board orders as follows:

In keeping with Appendix A, the Board corrects section 1 of Board Order 2017-08 to read: "YEC is to file correspondence with the Board within 30 days of issuance of the Yukon Court of Appeal order, as to when it expects to file the separate two-part application, as directed in Appendix A, to comply with the direction from the Yukon Court of Appeal and further directions from the Board."
