Re: Yukon Energy Corporation – Rider F Rate Change Advisory – October 1, 2012

Dear Mr. McLennan:

The Utilities Consumers' Group is in receipt of the Board's response regarding issues raised by UCG with respect to the Rider F that will become effective October 1, 2012. While UCG accepts that questions regarding the proposed Rider F change may be asked at the upcoming GRA hearing in November, UCG is concerned about over-recovery from ratepayers between October 1, 2012 and the date of the Board decision in the GRA proceedings.

UCG submits that the Rider F proposed to be applied to bills of Yukon ratepayers effective October 1, 2012 is artificially high due to the calculation errors and efficiency numbers contained in the rate calculations. Given that it does not appear as though the proposed Rider F is interim or refundable, UCG asks the Board to ensure that, should a corrected Rider F be determined during the 2012/2013 GRA proceeding, the correction will be effective October 1, 2012.

UCG requests a response.
