Dear Mr. McLennan and Mr. Morrison:

Re: Yukon Energy 2011-2030 Resource Plan

On August 14, 2012 Yukon Energy held a public meeting in Whitehorse to discuss the 2011-2030 Resource Plan update. At that meeting Mr. Morrison kindly offered to have his staff walk me through the modeling numbers that led to a graph like figure (but with circles) that concludes the Resource Plan Backgrounder. The modeling discussion with Yukon Energy staff took place on September 13, 2012. Some of the information I was requesting, I was told, could not be provided because Yukon Energy is before the Board with a GRA and the Resource Plan is now on the record at the GRA (in response to an IR).

In order to examine and test the numbers presented in the Resource Plan and then to comment on the Resource Plan as a member of the public, I sought information referred to in the paragraph above. However, in response to LE-YEC-2-6 (and also YCS-YEC-2-5) Yukon Energy states that there is an opportunity in the current GRA proceeding to examine and ask questions about the Resource Plan Overview.

Given what I was told on September 13 and the subsequent information contained in response to round 2 IRs I am now uncertain as to how to proceed with requesting the desired information of Yukon Energy (some of which they could not provide to me on September 13 because of the GRA).

Should the questions I have concerning the Resource Plan (related to data and assumptions required to test the modeling results provided in the Resource Plan Overview) be presented as IRs? Round 2 IR process is complete but from round 2 IR responses it appears that the GRA proceeding is the appropriate forum for questions on the Resource Plan. Should my questions be a supplement to round 2 or a new round 3?

Since all parties to the GRA should have the same information with respect to the Resource Plan, I would like the responses to my questions, once submitted and answered, be provided to all parties.

In response to round 2 IRs, Yukon Energy indicates that they can consider comments received on the Resource Plan until mid to late November. The extra time is much appreciated (the end of September was the previous indicated cut-off for public comments).

This letter has only been sent to the Board and Yukon Energy, once your decision(s) have been made I will communicate accordingly to all parties with respect to the Resource Plan as it connects to the GRA process.

I look forward to your response.
