Re: Yukon Energy Request for Interim Refundable Rates

Dear Ms. Shanks:

Further to Board letter October 17, 2008 the UCG offers the following.

1. The sales of electricity to Minto Explorations should immediately benefit other ratepayers and be reflected on all billings.

2. A mechanism already exists to reflect this requested flow through and that is Rider J, now called the YEC Revenue Shortfall Rider (currently at 14.93% added to our billing).

This can appropriately be renamed as Interim YEC Revenue Surplus Rider at -2.87 per cent

(17.8-14.93) subtracted from our billings.

3. Any tampering with the rate design is not recommended until such time as the YEC revenue requirement is fully tested under a Phase 1. Then a Phase 11 process could appropriately determine a new rate structure using all the necessary information from the

YEC and YECL Phase 1 as well as a complete cost-of-service study.
