Dear Ms. Lemke:

The purpose of this letter is to apply to the Yukon Utilities Board for the costs which the Utilities Consumers' Group ("UCG") incurred during the 2011 Yukon Energy Rate Schedule 39 Application proceedings.

The Utilities Consumers' Group represents the interests of residential and small business ratepayers with our main goal of seeing well-managed, efficient electrical utilities maintaining relatively stable rates to firm consumers..

UCG was granted intervener status for this process through Board Order 2011-02. The UCG intervenor application letter to the Board referred the retainer of Mr. Pat McMahon (PaTina Energy Consultatant) as regulatory consultant to preform the duties necessary to make an informed intervention. Mr. McMahon has over 25 years experience in the energy and regulatory related fields. The Board has all of his credentials and experience on file.

Each individual allocation is outlined in the consultants' cost claim statement with hours documented for each in brackets.

UCG submits that all of the above claimed labours were part and parcel of this Yukon Energy review and necessary steps to this regulatory process. It was necessary to study the application, all supporting materials, pertinent regulatory legislation and OICs regarding Rate 39; prepare and submit IRs; review all IRs and responses; prepare Notice of Motion; prepare final argument, prepare reply argument. Therefore, each of these cost items should be considered relevant to this rate application and granted cost recovery.

UCG notes that we were the only intervenor that participated in all aspects of this process.
