_Re: Letter from YUB dated 07/03/09, Minister's Letter dated 07/03/05 and the YEC - Minto PPA Review / Order Process _

I recommend that the YUB take the opportunity, occasioned by the Minister's letter, to suspend the current paper hearing process for the PPA and redirect / combine the Review / Order Process so that a full and fair Part 3 public hearing can be conducted.

It is the sale of power to Minto, and the terms of that sale by YEC via the PPA, that will determine whether or not the Carmacks to Stewart Transmission Line and associated Power Projects are prudent and viable. Without a PPA there can be no power line. Thus it is incumbent on all parties to ensure that the PPA is fully tested and, if required, modified by YUB Order so that the finalized PPA is fair and reasonable in all respects.

If the YUB continues to proceed with the current, and what I view as an unfair, paper hearing process of the PPA and subsequently issues an order regarding the PPA, a future Part 3 Review hearing (whether public or paper) would likely prove redundant and wasteful.
