**BOARD ORDER 2011-11**

**WHEREAS:**

- A. On June 30, 2011, the Yukon Electrical Company Ltd. (YECL) and the Yukon Energy Corporation (YEC) (jointly the Companies) filed an application with the Yukon Utilities Board (Board) seeking an Order from the Board for approval of the YEC & YECL Rider F — Fuel Adjustment Rider & Deferred Fuel Price Variance Policy (Policy).
- B. The Policy was filed in response to a direction from Board Order 2010-13 (issued December 30, 2010) which states:

Given the large swings in the balance of the Rider F account, the Board directs the Companies to provide a written policy, for approval by the Board, on how Rider F is to be managed at the time of the next filing to adjust the rate for Rider F, or at the latest by June 30, 2011. Secondly, to allow all interested parties to monitor the balance in the Rider F account, the Companies are to provide to the Board quarterly acknowledgement filings stating the balance in the Rider F account and concurrently posting those filings on each company's website for easy public access<sup>1</sup>.

- C. The Companies stated that the written policy outlines the administration of the deferred fuel price variance account and sets out how Rider F changes are administered in Yukon based on well established past practice and specific order of the Government of Yukon (OIC 1995/90).

- D. The Board issued Board Order 2011-10 outlining a written process and schedule for this proceeding. In that Board Order, the Board directed intervenors to register with the Board by August 8, 2011.
- E. The Board received applications for intervenor status from the Utilities Consumers' Group, and John Maissan, Leading Edge Projects Inc.
- F. The Board received correspondence from YECL on August 9, 2011, requesting approval for an extension to the proceeding schedule as follows:

- G. On August 10, 2011, the Board invited Parties to make comments on the YECL request by August 12, 2011. The Board received no submissions from Parties with respect to this request.
