Re: Yukon Energy Corporation (“YEC”) Part 1 Energy Reconciliation Adjustment

This letter is provided on behalf of the City of Whitehorse (the “City”) pursuant to the schedule set out in Order 2018-01 of the Yukon Utilities Board.

The City has reviewed the arguments filed by Yukon Energy Corporation, Utilities Consumers’ Group and ATCO Electric Yukon (“AEY”) and although it affirms that it does not object to the application as filed, the City would make the following brief reply comments arising from the argument filed on behalf of AEY.

The City notes AEY’s comments regarding the complexity of the Diesel Contingency Fund (“DCF”) and Energy Reconciliation Adjustment (“ERA”) and its concerns that the DCF may be resulting in a shift of operational risk to customers. AEY suggests that on a go forward basis, consideration should be given to less complex alternatives, and that some discussion regarding these mechanisms may occur in the ERA Part 2 filing. The City is interested in participating in this future discussion, and exploring alternatives.
