It is my understanding that the Yukon Utilities Board is currently reviewing the proposal put forward by Yukon Energy Corporation (YEC) for the installation of a Liquefied Natural Gas generator(s). I would like to provide my comments to YUB about this proposal.

As a resident of Whitehorse, I'm completely opposed to YEC's LNG proposal for several reasons:

- This project would encourage the development of local fracking, a process known to use huge quantities of water, and contamination of ground water with toxic chemicals.
- It would divert public funds which would be much better used in the development of alternate energy systems (wind, solar).
- Public funds would be better used in the replacement of the old diesel generators with new diesel ones installed in the existing facility.

I urge the Yukon Utilities Board to recommend to the government to reject YEC's LNG project.
