Re YCS/LE submission re YEC LNG Project Proceeding

The Yukon Utilities Board (Board) acknowledges your letter of March 26, 2014 on behalf of your clients, Yukon Conservation Society and Leading Edge Inc. (YCS/LE). Your letter states:

“YCSLE expects to file in evidence 15 hard copies of the documents listed below from the YESAB and YEC websites on the first day of the oral hearing with the exceptions of documents number 4 and 5. They are very lengthy and only those pages that may be used in cross examination will be filed.”

Please note that the deadline for intervenor evidence was March 6, 2014. It is unclear whether you are tendering these documents as YCS/LE evidence or if you intend to use the documents in your cross-examination of the Applicant. If the purpose of your letter is to file the referenced documents as YCS/LE evidence, the Board cannot accept the documents as evidence without a motion from YCS/LE explaining the relevance of the documents to the Board’s mandate in this matter. If such a motion is filed, the Board will rule on whether or not the documents may be filed.

If you intend to use the documents referenced in your letter as aids to cross-examination, please note that the Board does not accept the documents on the record unless and until the document is used in cross-examination. However, counsel for the witness is to receive the aids to cross-examination at least 24 hours prior to the questions pertaining to the document being asked.
