# THE YUKON ELECTRICAL COMPANY LIMITED, AND YUKON ENERGY CORPORATION DECISION 1990-2 DATED MAY 1, 1990

### YUKON UTILITIES BOARD DECISION 1990-2

#### TUESDAY, THE 1st DAY OF MAY, A.D. 1990.

IN THE MATTER OF the "Public Utilities Act", being Chapter 143 of the Revised Statutes of Yukon, 1986, as amended;

AND IN THE MATTER OF applications by The Yukon Electrical Company Limited and Yukon Energy Corporation to the Yukon Utilities Board for Orders approving changes in existing rates, tolls or charges for electric light, power or energy and related services supplied to its customers within Yukon.

#### BEFORE:

THE YUKON UTILITIES BOARD

#### ORDER

WHEREAS The Yukon Electrical Company Limited ("YECL") and Yukon Energy Corporation ("YEC") ("the Companies") filed Applications dated December 30, 1988 with the Yukon Utilities Board ("the Board") for Orders of the Board fixing and approving just and reasonable rates, charges or schedules thereof for electric light, power or energy and related services to be supplied by YECL and YEC, including terms and conditions of service;

AND WHEREAS by Interim Orders 1989-1 and 1989-2 dated March 17, 1989 the Board fixed and approved interim rates to be effective for billings issued on and after April 1, 1989 for consumption on and after March 1, 1989 and approved Electric Service Regulations on an interim basis;

AND WHEREAS the Board, following public hearings, issued Decisions 1989-3, 1989-4 and 1989-5 dated October 20, 1989 wherein it approved the 1989 and 1990 revenue requirements of YEC, and directed YECL to prepare and file with the Board a revised calculation of total utility revenue requirement for 1989 and 1990 in accordance with the three aforementioned Decisions;

AND WHEREAS in Decision 1989-5 the Board ordered as follows:

"The Yukon Electrical Company Limited and Yukon Energy Corporation shall prepare and file with the Board within thirty (30) days a schedule of just and reasonable rates and appropriate riders for the test years 1989 and 1990 in accordance with Decisions 1989-3, 1989-4 and this Decision."

AND WHEREAS by letters dated November 14 and 27, 1989 YEC applied to the Board for a rehearing of Decision 1989-4, and YECL and YEC applied to the Board for an extension of the date for the filing of material as required by Orders 1989-3 and 1989-5;

AND WHEREAS the Board, following a public hearing, issued Decision 1990-1 dated March 19, 1990 wherein it denied YEC's application for a rehearing under Section 27 of the Board's Rules of Practice on the basis that YEC had not established that a rehearing was warranted;

AND WHEREAS in its Decision 1990-1 the Board ordered that YECL and YEC shall prepare and file with the Board within ten (10) days a schedule of just and reasonable rates and appropriate riders for the test years 1989 and 1990 in accordance with Decisions 1989-3, 1989-4 and 1989-5 for implementation on April 1, 1990;

AND WHEREAS on March 28, 1990 YECL and YEC filed with the Board a Joint Response to Decision 1990-1 wherein they proposed revised rates and riders to be effective on all billings on and after April 1, 1990;

AND WHEREAS on April 3, 1990 the Board forwarded copies of the Joint Response to all registered Intervenors;

AND WHEREAS on April 23, 1990 YECL filed an amendment to rate ENG-23, contained in the Joint Response to Decision 1990-1.

DECISION 1990-2

AND UPON considering that no Intervenor has filed an objection with the Board to the rates and riders proposed by YECL and YEC in the Joint Response;

AND UPON considering that the Joint Response is reasonable and consistent with prior Orders of the Board relating to YECL and YEC;

5. The interim rates, tolls and charges approved in Decisions 1989-1 and 1989-2 are hereby fixed and approved as just, reasonable and final rates, tolls and charges for the period from April 1, 1989 to April 1, 1990.
