BOARD ORDER 2021-13 — ERRATUM

WHEREAS:

- A. Pursuant to Section 56 of the *Public Utilities Act*, the Yukon Utilities Board (“the Board”) may “order to whom or by whom any costs incidental to any proceeding before the Board are to be paid, and may set the costs to be paid”;
- B. On September 26, 2021, the Board issued Board Order 2021-13 with respect to costs awards for YEC’s Proposed Battery Energy Storage System (BESS Project)proceeding;
- C. The Board’s costs included amounts incurred for the current fiscal year of \$102,718.60, but did not include the 2020-21 fiscal year-end costs in the amount of \$32,971.06; and
- D. Because of this inadvertent error, Board Order 2021-13 requires a correction to the total amount that YEC is directed to pay Government of Yukon for Board costs related to the YEC BESS Project proceeding.

NOW THEREFORE, the Board Orders as follows:


1. YEC shall pay an additional \$32,971.06 to the Government of Yukon within 30 days of the issuance of this erratum to Board Order 2021-13.
2. Board Order 2021-13 is corrected in the second paragraph of section 3 to read:

The Board directs an award of costs to the Government of Yukon in the amount of \$135,689.66.
3. The Board corrects the order section of Board Order 2021-13 to reflect the actual amount awarded for hearing-related costs of the Government of Yukon (Board costs) to \$135,689.66, and the Board directs a total award of costs of \$219,518.69. The costs directed in Board Order 2021-13, as amended by this erratum, are as follows:
