WHEREAS:

- A. On July 7, 2023 Yukon Electrical Company Limited, carrying on business as ATCO Electric Yukon (AEY), filed an application (Application) with the Yukon Utilities Board (the Board) pursuant to *the Public Utilities Act* (the Act) and *Order-in-Council 1995/90*, requesting an order approving a forecast revenue requirement for \$60,992,000 in 2023 and \$68,096,000 in 2024. The Application also seeks approval of:
- An interim refundable rate rider (Rider R) of 6.68% effective August 1, 2023;
 - An interim refundable rate rider (Rider R) of 13.5% effective January 1, 2024;
 - Approval for the following deferral accounts:
 - Board Orders or legislative changes
 - Industrial Rider R Flow Through
 - Purchased Power Flow Through
 - Independent Power Producers (IPP) Flow Through
 - Diesel Fuel Deferral Account;
- B. The Board issued Board Order 2023-13 on July 14, 2023, in which the Board set out a process schedule pending Ministerial approval. In that schedule, interveners had until August 4, 2023 to register for this proceeding;

- C. The Board received Ministerial approval for this proceeding dated July 20, 2023;
- D. The Board received requests for intervener status from the Yukon Energy Corporation (YEC), the Utilities Consumers' Group (UCG), John Maissan, Nathaniel Yee, Florian Boulais, the Yukon NDP Caucus, and the Yukon Conservation Society;
- E. The Board received a letter of comment on August 1, 2023 from the Canadian Federation of Independent Business (CFIB) representing over 150 small business members in the Yukon. The CFIB did not specifically request intervener status;
- F. The Board received correspondence from Frank Bachmier on July 27, 2023 requesting to make a presentation at the next public hearing; and
- G. The Board has reviewed the requests for intervener status.

NOW THEREFORE, the Board orders that:

- 1. Intervener status is granted to the following for this proceeding:
 - a. YEC;
 - b. UCG;
 - c. John Maissan;
 - d. Nathaniel Yee;
 - e. Florian Boulais;
 - f. Yukon NDP Caucus; and
 - g. Yukon Conservation Society.
- 2. Presenter status is granted to the following for this proceeding:
 - a. Frank Bachmier
 - b. CFIB
