Summary of Application

The Yukon Energy Corporation (YEC) has filed an application with the Yukon Utilities Board (Board) requesting an order approving its forecast revenue requirements for the two-year test period 2023 and 2024 (Application). YEC is the main generator and transmitter of electrical energy in the Yukon and directly serves over 2,300 customers in and around Dawson City, Mayo, and Faro and two industrial customers.

YEC is seeking approval of forecast net revenue requirements of \$80,688 million for 2023 and \$89,673 for 2024. This represents an increase of \$6,667 million for 2023 over revenues from existing rates and riders of \$74.021 million (9.0% increase). For 2024, this represents an increase of \$8,985 million over the proposed 2023 revenue requirement (11.1% increase).

In addition, in its Application, YEC is also seeking approval of an interim refundable rate rider (Rider J) increase for 2023 of 4.80%, bringing Rider J to 39.64%, applicable to base rates for retail and industrial firm rates, effective October 1, 2023. YEC is also requesting a further Rider J increase of 12.02%, bringing Rider J to 51.66% for retail and industrial firm rates, effective January 1, 2024. YEC is seeking final rates effective August 1, 2024.

Technical workshop

YEC will hold a technical workshop regarding the Application on **Wednesday, October 11, 2023** at a time and venue to be determined by YEC in Whitehorse, Yukon. YEC is also to provide a virtual option for the technical workshop. The technical workshop is designed to assist the public in gaining a better understanding of the Application and process surrounding the Application.

Hearing

An oral public hearing will take place in Whitehorse regarding the Application. The Whitehorse location of the hearing will be determined by the Board at a later date.
