The Yukon Conservation Society wishes to apply for Intervener status in regards to the Yukon Utility Board May 15<sup>th</sup>, 2007 oral hearings regarding the proposed Carmacks-Stewart Transmission Project, as detailed in Board Order 2007-4.

Issues the Yukon Conservation Society intends to pursue include, but are not limited to:

- the Low Grade Ore Processing Secondary Energy Rate
- the PPA provisions regarding YEC purchase of the diesel units at the Minto Mine
- the PPA provisions regarding Mine Spur decommissioning costs
- the relationship between Stage One of the Carmacks-Stewart Transmission Project and the need for and the timing of the Aishihik third turbine

The Yukon Conservation Society does not intend, at this stage, to hire legal counsel and/or consultants. However, the Yukon Conservation Society reserves the right to hire legal counsel and/or consultants at any time during the hearing.
