I am attaching here the recent Board Order regarding the Carmacks-Stewart Transmission Project proceeding. Please note section 2 on page 4 that deals with Intervenor applications. According to that section, Parties seeking Intervenor status are to provide the following information to the Board by April 13, 2007:

- i. issues the party intends to pursue;
- ii. whether the party intends to hire legal counsel and/or consultants and, if so:
 - . the qualifications of each professional
 - . the retainer letter for each professional
 - . a description of why each professional is required; and
- iii. whether the party intends to file evidence and, if so, on what issues.
