I wish to be registered as an intervenor in the above referenced Phase II Proceedings.

I am primarily interested in obtaining factual information on the true historic actual costs of providing electrical services to each of the rate classes in the current isolated diesel communities of Old Crow, Destruction Bay / Burwash, Beaver Creek, Swift River and Watson Lake and in the previously isolated but recently grid (hydro) connected communities of Dawson City, Stewart Crossing and Pelly Crossing. I wish to know and understand how these actual current and historic costs of service are reconciled and reflected in the Utilities' proposed fully distributed cost of service study and rate design methods.

Having accurate information on actual costs in the isolated communities should assist the Board and other intervenors in assessing whether or not and to what degree the proposed fully distributed cost of service study is obscuring subsidization and cross subsidization beyond that which may be unavoidable due to rate equalization OICs.

Knowing the actual community costs will assist all parties in focusing attention on future cost saving possibilities relating to conservation and competitive initiatives.
