Re: GRA Phase II Undertaking No. 4, page 152 (uncorrected transcript), YECL to Leading Edge

On October 12, 2010 the response to above captioned undertaking was received from YECL. I am disappointed to report that this information is less helpful than the original answer to LE-YEC/YECL-1-31, as it now includes customers who only had secondary wire required to hook them up. Clearly no other customers will connect to a customer's secondary wire and thus not cost sharing will never be applicable. Also, based on the wording of the undertaking response all projects that cost \$25,000 or more in customer contributions are included whereas Leading Edge was asking whether the numbers provided in the original IR response represented the number of distribution extension projects to which one or more customers connected or represented the number of individual customers who paid above the specified contribution levels.

The information that was being asked for is a sub set of the original response. The original response may include some individual customer distribution extensions and, most likely, it also includes several distribution extensions to which more than one customer connected and for which there was a sharing of common costs.

During the breaks in the hearing YECL staff approached me on the matter and we had some good productive conversations. If I have understood correctly it may be that the information I am seeking is not easily available because, for example, if there are 10 customers that connect to one distribution line extension, it may be seen as 10 separate projects in the record keeping of the utilities (rather than one project) because each individual customer will likely have differing individual costs for connecting to that one new distribution line.

Despite the absence of the information I was seeking I believe that I can provide a supported argument on the cost sharing period that is of particular interest to Braeburn Lake Christian Camp. I would like the record to be clear that I was not able to obtain the information with

respect to the number of distribution line extension projects as opposed to individual customer connections that I was I was seeking.
