**Re: Rider F - Quarterly Report - Period Ending March 31, 2019**

Board Order 2010-13 directs the companies as follows:

" ... to allow all interested parties to monitor the balance in the Rider F account, the Companies are to provide the Board quarterly acknowledgement filings stating the balance in the Rider F account... "

Please find attached a quarter end report regarding the Companies' combined Diesel Fuel Price Variance ("Rider F") account balance for the period ended March 31, 2019.

It should be noted that a Rider F change was implemented on August 1, 2017 to address a cumulative balance in excess of the \$200,000 threshold. However we are currently exceeding the \$200,000 threshold, but due to Yukon Energy being in the process of a GRA, the rate will remain until the completion of the GRA. At such time the Rider F rate will be reviewed to determine if a rate change is required.
