**Re: Rider F - Quarterly Report - Period Ending June 30, 2022**

Yukon Utilities Board ("Board") Order 2010-13 directs the companies as follows:

" ... to allow all interested parties to monitor the balance in the Rider F account, the Companies are to provide the Board quarterly acknowledgement filings stating the balance in the Rider F account... "

Please find attached a quarter end report regarding the Companies' combined Diesel and LNG Fuel Price Variance ("Rider F") account balance for the period ended June 30, 2022. The account balance exceeds the \$200,000 threshold set by the Board, therefore, on July 5, 2022 the Companies filed Rider F rate change advisory letter with the Board with Rider F rate of 0.865 cents/kWh effective August 1, 2022 to address the account balance.
