Re: Information Requests (IRs) to YEC Concerning the Power Purchase Agreement (PPA) between YEC and Minto Exploration Ltd.

I respectfully request that the YUB accept this letter as full support for the UCG's Notice of Motion, via its letter to the YUB dated 07/03/12.

In addition, I respectfully ask that the YUB accept this letter as a further Notice of Motion whereby I request, under the YUB Rules of Practice (11, 12 & 19), that the Board consider and provide rulings / orders with respect to my first round of IRs on the following:

PWP-YEC-1-9 & -1-10

The answers provided are inadequate. The answers may have been adequate for the Resource Plan orders of magnitude cost estimates. But at this point in time, it is incredible that YEC does not have preliminary detailed cost estimates for the Mine Spur and the Carmacks to Minto Landing main line. How could YEC possibly consider entering into a very complex multi-million dollar, multi-year PPA with Minto without first having this critical information as the basis for prudent negotiations?

If YEC does have such estimates I respectfully request that the YUB require YEC to produce them forthwith.

If YEC truly does not have these estimates then I respectfully request that the YUB require YEC to prepare them immediately so that these preliminary detailed cost estimates will be available for adequate advanced review by all parties prior to this hearing process proceeding further.

PWP-YEC-1-27

There are in total $(9 + 8 + 1 + 2) = 20$ **Prior Security Interests** listed in **SCHEDULE 1** including the Macquarie Bank Limited. I asked for the dollar amounts (values) for each and all of these. The answer provided by YEC does not give the dollar amount for a single one.

I respectfully request that the YUB require YEC to provide all this information as soon as possible.
